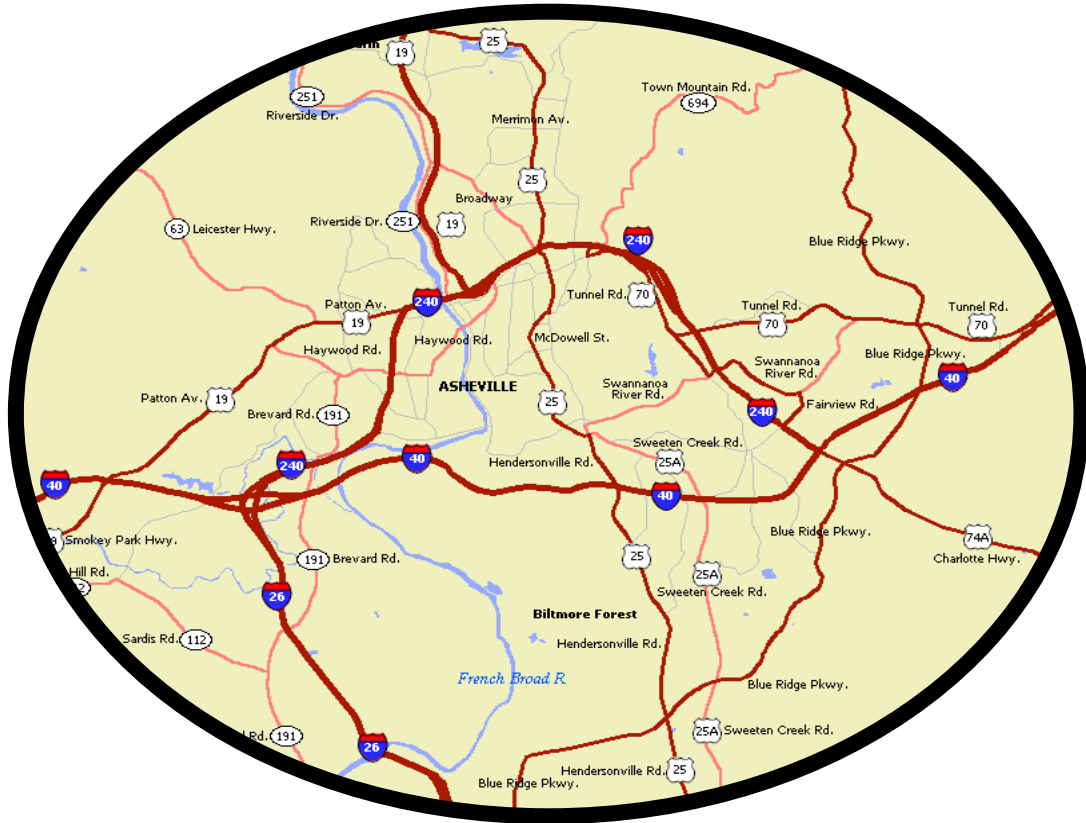

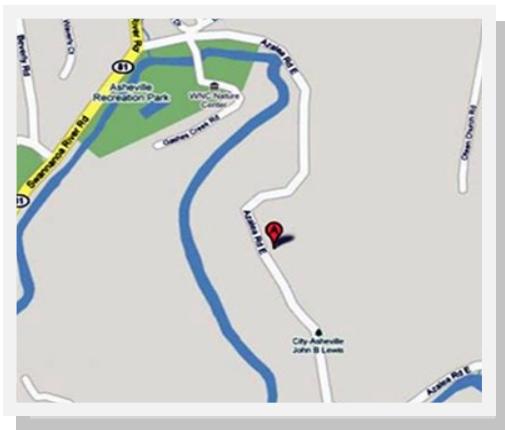


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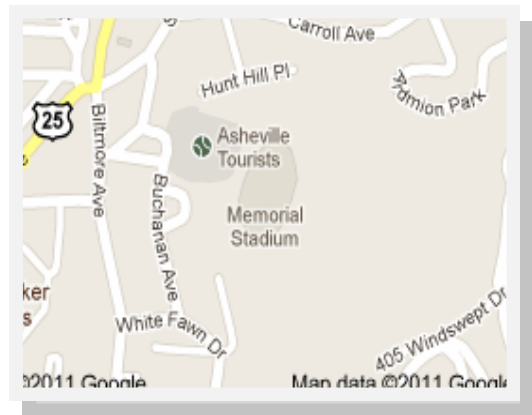
AREA MAP

DIRECTIONS

To Asheville, NC:

From Charlotte Area

- Take Interstate 85 S toward Gastonia/Spartansburg.
- Take exit 17 for US-321 N. Follow US-321 until exit 43B and merge onto I 40 toward Asheville
- Take exit 50B to merge onto US-25 N/Hendersonville Rd toward Asheville/Biltmore Estate
- End on 115 Hendersonville Rd, at the DoubleTree hotel.

From Knoxville, Tennessee Area (West)

- Travel East on I-40
- Take exit 50 for US-25 toward S Asheville
- Turn left at Hendersonville Rd
- End at 115 Hendersonville Rd. at the DoubleTree hotel

From Greensboro, Raleigh, Hickory, and Winston-Salem (East)

- Travel West on I-40
- Take exit 50B to merge onto US-25 N/Hendersonville Rd toward Asheville/Biltmore Estate

Alternative Game Days

In the event a climate condition render the field surfaces unplayable, the tournament will move back one day.

Awards

The winning team and individual awards will be awarded after each Championship game on Saturday, November 5th. All-American and National All-Academic Team will be awarded to individuals at the Championship Banquet on Thursday, November 3rd.

Banquet

The Championship Banquet will be held on Thursday, November 3rd at The Crowne Plaza Hotel. Doors will open at 6:30pm and dinner will be served at 7:00pm. The cost will be \$20.00 to attend the banquet. We ask that all participants dress appropriately and refrain from wearing sweat suites, blue jeans and t-shirts. This banquet will feature a guest speaker.

Championship Format

The 2011 National Tournament shall consist of eight men's and eight women's soccer teams. The team that is ranked the highest for the tournament will play the lowest ranked team (#1 vs. #8, #2 vs. #7, etc.). Teams will be guaranteed at least two games during the tournament. Each game will be 90 minutes in duration and if needed two 10 minute golden goal extra time periods, followed by penalty kicks if they game is still tied. Winners will move on to the Semi-Final game and the non-winning teams will play in the Consolation round on Friday. Winners from Game #7 and #8 will move on to the Championship game on Saturday and the non-winners will be eliminated from the tournament.

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Coaches Meeting

The Coaches Meeting will be held at the Crowne Plaza Hotel on Thursday at 8:30pm. This is for the purpose of reviewing any of the last minute changes that need to be made before the next day of the tournament. (I.E. Game times, game day, uniforms, and weather).

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Officials

All officials will be college certified and experienced at the collegiate level. Three officials will be present for each game: a center official and two assistant officials. In the consolation round only two officials will be used. Some officials will work back-to-back games, but the center official may only run the center in one game per day.

Parking

Parking will be available at both the John B. Lewis Soccer Facility and at Memorial Field. Parking will be free of charge, and ample parking space will be available for busses and vehicles.

Photographs

Professional action photographs will be taken during the tournament. The photographer will attempt to get most of the schools in action.

If your institution, players, friends, or family members wish to purchase any of these photographs, the photographer will have contact information available.

Practice Facilities

If a team is looking to practice on Wednesday, November 2nd (the day before the start of the tournament) please contact Stacey Enos with the desired time at least one week before the start of the tournament.

Rules to Note

The USCAA Tournament will follow the NCAA rules:

Overtime—Two 10 minute Golden Goal extra periods then Penalty Kicks

Substitutions—First half, NO re-entry; Second half, ONE re-entry; First & Second Overtime—NO re-entry

Soccer Balls

Six to 10 practice balls will be provided for each time for warm-ups and 4-5 game balls will be provided at each tournament site.

One game ball from the Championship Game will be awarded to the tournament winner.

Uniforms

The higher seeded institution will wear light color uniforms and the lower seed will wear dark colored uniforms. If a lower seed upsets a higher seed, in the following round the higher seed institution will still wear light color uniforms (ex. If #8 beats the #1 seed in the first round, #8 will still wear light uniforms).
